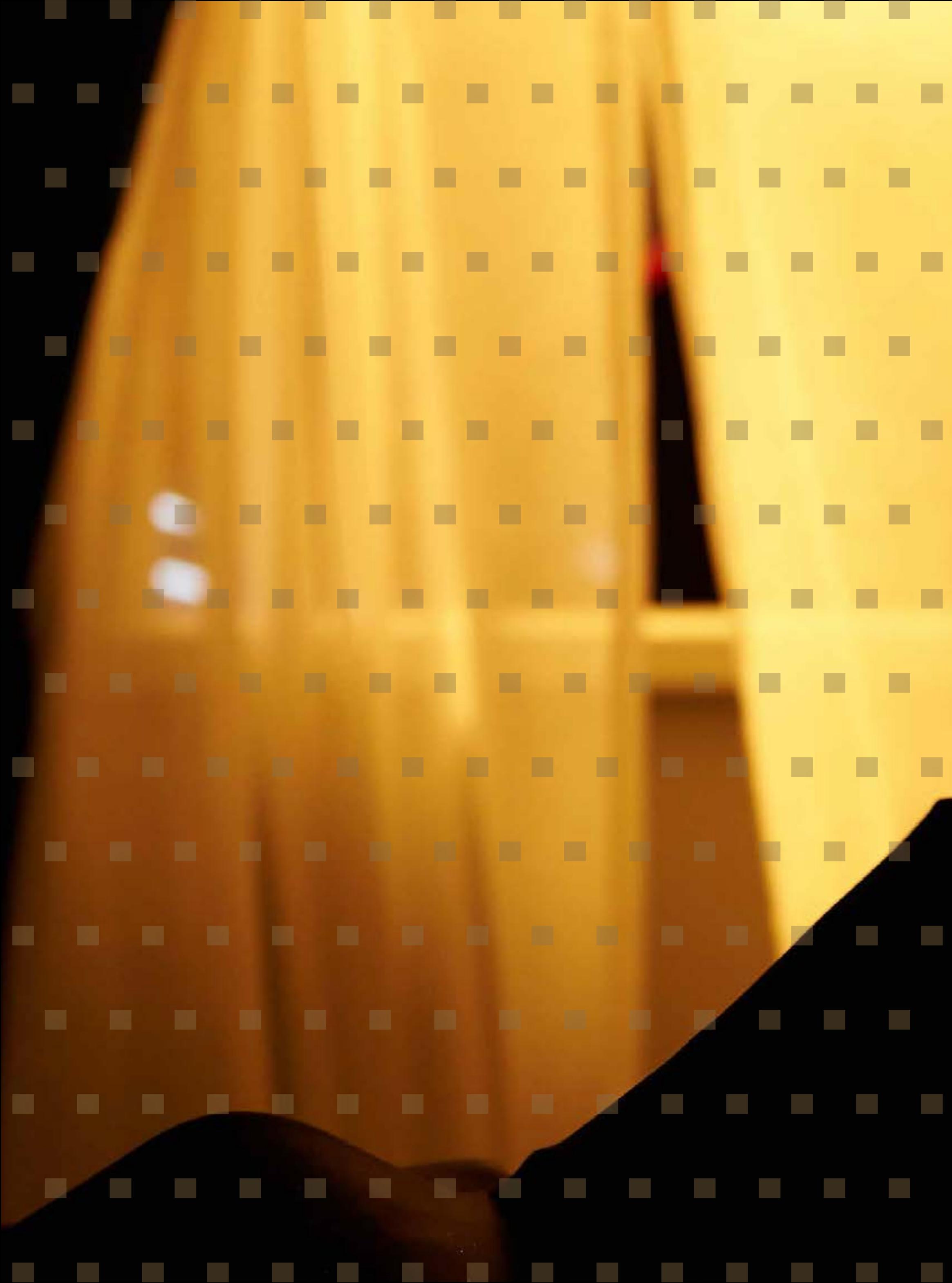
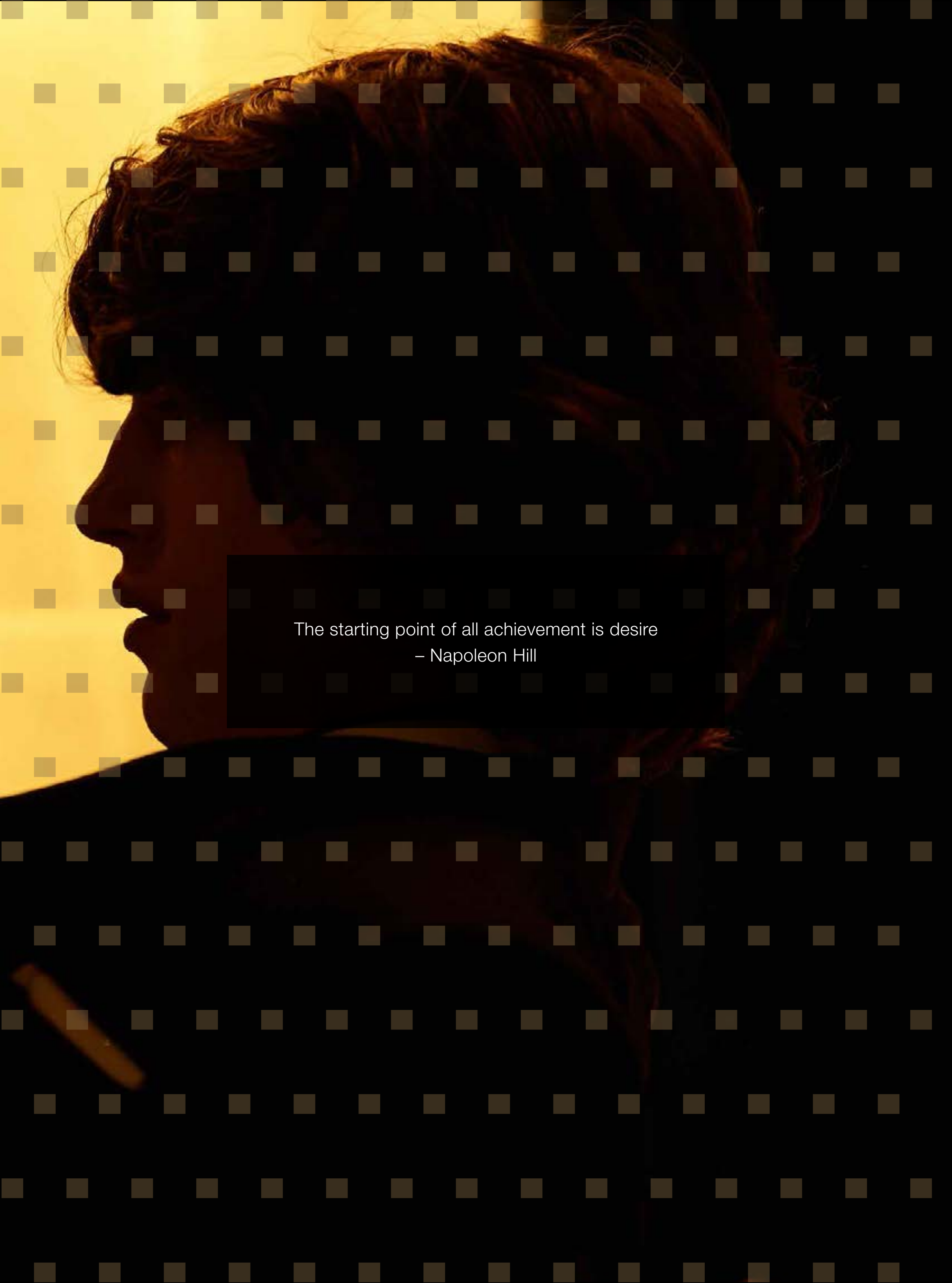

NIGHT FALL

DRIVEN BY DESIRE

As a considered and striking residence of 45 apartments over seven levels, Night Fall has been designed in the great modernist tradition, deriving its geometric form from the demands of its function, the orchestration of its materials and the beauty of its surrounds. Both considered and luxurious, residents of Night Fall's superbly appointed one, two and three bedroom apartments are welcomed into curated spaces of exquisite materials and finishes, where warm palettes of industrial elements, such as anodised bronze panelling, are offset by softer textured off-white exterior treatments and polished edges.

Carefully considered and light filled spaces are framed by generous balconies and an orientation that maximises natural daylight. Paying homage to Melbourne's great laneways, the select balconies fronting Gladstone Street and corresponding laneways create a sense of inner-CBD living while providing a strong connection between interior and exterior living spaces. Supported by an innovative carstacking carpark and generous secure storage spaces, residents of Night Fall are afforded the conveniences expected from a luxurious and boutique residence.

Night Fall is situated less than 1.5 kilometres from the city centre and upon the nexus of Melbourne's most celebrated cultural hub. Serving as a cultural barometer and beacon, Night Fall rests discretely at the entrance of Melbourne's entertainment and recreation precincts, the excitement and colour of which is matched only by the grandeur and serenity of nearby parklands and picturesque Port Phillip Bay.

With stunning city views to the north-east and bay views to the south-west, Night Fall is simultaneously a sanctuary and stage with residents afforded the luxury to participate in the haptic energy of local markets and cafés or curate a unique in-house entertaining experience.

One cannot speak of Night Fall's architectural presence without the attribution of DKO Architects. Widely recognised as an award winning architecture and design practice, DKO Architecture's enviable reputation has been developed through the meticulous planning of living environments and the integration of internal and external living spaces. EXPERIENCE

CENTRAL AND DISTINGUISHED

To know a city one must discover its secrets, listen to its heartbeat and take part in its performance. In knowing Melbourne one can easily recall what makes it unique and magnetic. As a city of firsts, Melbourne is also no stranger to the world stage. In its early and defining years, Melbourne was the first city within Australia to hold a Federal Parliament, the first to host the Olympic Games and the first to host the sport of kings at Albert Park in 1875. A jewel in Melbourne's cultural crown, the first public art gallery in Australia was The National Gallery of Victoria, founded in 1861 and situated only 2kms from Night Fall. Like a beautiful sonata of sorts, Melbourne is simultaneously composed and performed by its inhabitants, historic landmarks and precincts. From the haptic energy of South Melbourne Market to the distinctly european sensibilities of Lygon Street, Melbourne presents a unique kaleidoscope of cosmopolitan life.

Standing central and distinguished, Night Fall is just 2kms from Melbourne's Art Precinct, home to many of Australia's premiere companies including The Australian Ballet, Melbourne Theatre Company and the Australian Centre for Contemporary Art. Should one desire more culinary pursuits, Melbourne's treasured inner city landmark and quintessential South Melbourne Market is situated only 0.6kms from Night Fall offering an energetic and heady mix of vibrant restaurants and incredible fresh produce.

The picturesque Albert Park Lake is situated just 1.85kms from Night Fall and encompasses 2.25 square kilometres of parklands and recreational facilities. Delivering a grassy wetland habitat for nearly two hundred bird species and over 117 native and exotic plant species, the biodiversity of the parkland is complimented by a suite of modern sporting facilities including the Albert Park Public Golf Course, Melbourne Grand Prix Circuit and The Albert Park Yacht club, the oldest continuing yacht club in Victoria standing proudly at the edge of the lake since 1871. A five kilometre walking track around the lake is the best way to experience the park and the surrounding suburbs of Albert Park, Middle Park and St Kilda.

For over 170 years, Melbourne's retail precincts have been considered Australia's best. Collins Street, the grandest street within the city, is located just 2.3kms from Night Fall and is celebrated for its mix of glamour and charm. An assemblage of five star hotels, iconic churches, live theatres, Town Hall and world class gastronomic delights is matched by unrivalled five star shopping with brands such as Cartier, Hermes, Bulgari, Paspaley, Louis Vuitton and Tiffany & Co calling Melbourne home. Collins Street, like much of Melbourne is serviced by a famous tram network and has easy access from three train stations.






